DESTINATIONS

OI Pejeta Conservancy, Lake Elementaita & Maasai Mara Game Reserve

ITINERARY

Day 1:

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), you will be met and greeted at the Airport with an AsaRay Tours officer. He / She will assist you with your luggage after which he/ she will accompany you to transfer to your Hotel. Check in your Hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 2:

Early in the morning, you will depart and drive to OI Pejeta Conservancy. Black rhinos thrive at the 90,000-acre [OI Pejeta Conservancy](#), home to eastern Africa's biggest black rhino sanctuary. There's also an on-site sanctuary that nurses injured chimps back to health. During your two nights in this park, you'll get up close and personal with these and more exotic beasts on game walks and nighttime game drives. The visit also includes if and when possible a camel / horseback ride through the conservancy. With game viewing en route, you will arrive at the luxurious Sweetwaters Tented Camp for lunch.

Day 3:

Spend the entire day in OI Pejeta Conservancy embracing the unique beauty and activities in this Conservancy.

Day 4:

Depart OI Pejeta Conservancy after breakfast and drive to Lake Naivasha. One of Lake Naivasha's most striking sights is of hundreds of bright pink flamingoes gathered amid the papyrus reeds that surround this freshwater lake, one of two located in Kenya's Rift Valley. For an additional fee, visitors can take a boat ride on the lake, or hike and rock climb throughout the park, which is adjacent to the craggy, reddish cliffs of [Hell's Gate National Park](#). You will arrive at Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge in time for lunch.

Day 5:

The safari's final destination is Masai Mara National Reserve, home to Kenya's Big Five animals—elephants, buffalo, lions, rhinoceros, and leopards. In fact, the lion population here is so considerable that the park is the headquarters of the BBC's *Big Cat Diary*. The ideal time to visit is between July and October, when more than a million gazelle, wildebeests and zebras migrate through Mara River and into the reserve from the Serengeti. With game viewing en route, you will arrive at Ashnil Mara Camp in time for lunch. Enjoy an afternoon game drive in the park until sunset in search of animals.

Day 6:

Spend the day in Maasai Mara enjoying your morning and afternoon game drives. This is home to the famous Maasai people well known for their distinctive custom and dress. Early afternoon you will visit a typical Maasai village and enjoy being part of this unique culture and cultural habits that not even the western influence has been able to change. Later continue with your game drive until sunset returning to the Camp for dinner and overnight.

Day 7:

Spend the day in Maasai Mara Game Reserve still enjoying morning and afternoon game drives, ensuring to capture every arising opportunity. Early in the morning you have an option of doing an early morning Hot Air Balloon Safari + Champagne Breakfast (Optional at an extra cost of USD \$ 450 per person)

Day 8:

After breakfast, ***“full of lasting safari memories!”*** you will depart Maasai Mara Game Reserve and drive to Nairobi. On arrival in Nairobi, a visit to a local market where you can shop for souvenirs, African artifacts, jewelry etc would exciting. After which, you will be dropped off to own onward plans.
