



10 DAYS ADVENTURE & CULTURAL EXPERIENCE – CODE: ASA/CUL/RDT10

ITINERARY

Day 1: Nairobi

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport - JKIA (flight booked and confirmed by you), you will be met by an Asaray Tours representation. She/he will assist you with your luggage and thereafter accompany you on your transfer to your Hotel in Nairobi. On arrival at your Hotel for check in, he/she will do a short briefing on your adventure safari beginning the next day. All details that you need to know on the safari will be detailed out to you. Upon a satisfactory briefing, you will check in and spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure relaxing at your hotel.

Overnight at Panari Hotel - BB

Day 2: Nairobi – Maasai Mara Game Reserve

Early in the morning, at 0700hrs, your Driver/Guide will be ready at the hotels reception for you to start your adventure safari. Once through with your breakfast, at 0700hrs, join your Driver/Guide and immediately depart to drive to Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Maasai Mara is open grassland. 95 species of mammals, amphibians, reptiles and over 400 species of birds have been recorded in this park. In Maasai Mara you will hardly miss to see the BIG FIVE. The annual wildebeest migration takes place in this park between July and October. The eco system of Maasai Mara holds one of the highest Lion densities in the world and this is where over 2 million Wildebeest, Zebras and Thomson Gazelle migrate every year. You will enjoy the drive to Maasai Mara passing various Maasai traditional homes and villages and enjoying the scenic beauty along this road to arrive at the **Ashnil Mara Camp** in time for lunch. In the afternoon enjoy a game drive until sunset returning to the Camp in time for dinner.

Day 3: Maasai Mara Game Reserve

On this day, at 0630hrs, you will depart for an early morning game drive. This game drive is most recommended since at that time most animals hunting are up in search of their kill for the day! Return to the camp and have breakfast. Maasai Mara is home to the famous Maasai people well known for their distinctive custom and dress. After breakfast, you will collect your picnic lunch boxes from the Camps reception, after which you will depart to visit and spend the day in a typical Maasai village and enjoy being part of this unique culture and cultural habits that not even the western influence has been able to change. You will visit a typical Manyatta (Maasai homestead) and go through their daily lives, sit with the elders and even the Morans (warriors) and understand how a typical day is like and get to know how they are initiated into adulthood and thus become Morans. Enjoy a Maasai dance and if possible take part in jumping competition. See their artifacts and learn how they are made and meanings of certain ornaments they wear both male and female. Just discover the beauty of this culture! Late afternoon, bid them "kwaheri" meaning goodbye and depart with game viewing en route returning to the Camp for dinner and overnight.

Day 4: Maasai Mara Game Reserve

Spend the day in Maasai Mara Game Reserve still enjoying morning and afternoon game drives, ensuring to capture every arising opportunity. Early in the morning you have an option of doing an early morning Hot Air Balloon Safari + Champagne Breakfast (Optional at an extra cost of USD \$ 450 per person)

Day 5: Maasai Mara Game Reserve – Lake Victoria

After your breakfast in the morning, you will depart Maasai Mara and drive to Lake Victoria - Africa's largest inland Lake. Here you will visit the Ruma National Park famously referred to as "Last retreat of the Roan Antelope". This is the only Terrestrial park on the western side of Kenya. This is the only park in Kenya where you will find the Roan Antelope. Roan Antelope is an endangered species which is protected within Ruma National Park. Black Rhino, Leopards, Buffaloes, Rothschild Giraffe etc. and over 400 species of birds can be found in this park. You will arrive at the **Kiboko Bay Resort** in time for lunch. In the afternoon you will depart to Ruma National Park to enjoy the unique beauty of this park compared to the other parks in Kenya. After sunset drive back to your Resort for dinner and overnight.

Day 6: Lake Victoria

On this day you will wake up and have breakfast. After breakfast you will spend the day enjoying the adventure termed, "Best of Kisumu" which will take you through Lake, nature, History, people and the buzz of the daily life. Start your tour on Lake Victoria with a gorgeous sunrise cruise weaving through the Hippos and fishermen and not forgetting a bird species of about 300 birds! Visit the museum where you will learn about the history and culture of the region and the local tribe "Luo". Visit the Maasai souvenir market for spot gift shopping and also see the famous local market and thereafter have a leisurely lunch at a restaurant along the Lake. While away the afternoon in the tranquil setting of the Impala Sanctuary on the banks of Lake Victoria. Follow the many trails around the park, or simply sit quietly in the shade down by the lake and let the wild impala and zebra roam closer. A sun down at the Mythical "Kit Mikaye" rock watching a pink sunset over a dramatic boulder strewn landscape is the best way to end this day! Kit Mikaye rock is actually a collection of 7 huge boulders sitting atop a hillside in the rolling hills West of Kisumu. This unique rock has a cultural back ground / belief that will be given to you while there. Visit to see and be struck by this awesome feature of nature! Return to the Resort for dinner and overnight.

Day 7: Lake Victoria – Kakamega National Forest Reserve

Wake up in your luxurious tents to the invigorating sounds of various birds and beautiful sunshine. You will have your breakfast, after which you will depart the Lake side city of Kisumu and drive to Kakamega Forest National Reserve. Cast off those African stereotype images of savannah, acacia trees and lions and immerse yourself in Kenya's ultimate eco-experience: deepest, darkest, greenest, tropical rain forest. This park offers unique wildlife and scenic beauty. You will visit "the crying stone" another unique feature found in Western Kenya which the villagers gave the name due to the high rock boulder having water running downwards all through. Enjoy the rich cultural / mythical background surrounding this rock and understand how it affects the local people. Depart to check in at the luxurious Golf Hotel in time for lunch. Spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure enjoying the facilities at the hotel and if the sun is shiny dive into the swimming pool.

Day 8: Kakamega National Forest Reserve

In the morning wake up and have breakfast. After breakfast, with your picnic lunches, be ready to take on a full day of adventure in the African jungle – ‘Kakamega Forest.’ Spend the day walking the trails in the forest reserve, the last section of lush, tropical rain forest in Kenya. Watch the monkeys crashing about in the canopies overhead. Be keen to learn the medicinal values of the indigenous and swing on the vines. Stop off at the crashing rapids of the river Yala as it forces its way through the overgrown jungle. Learn about the conservation work of a local community group. In the afternoon, after your lunch, for about an hour trek to the highest point of the park where there are stunning views across the forest. Later afternoon visit a nearby village to the home of a local butterfly farmer and enjoy! Later evening return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9: Kakamega National Forest Reserve – Lake Nakuru National Park

Early morning take your breakfast. After breakfast, depart Kakamega and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park. Lake Nakuru is one of the Rift Valley Soda Ash Lakes. The Lakes abundance of algae attracts the vast quantity of Flamingoes that famously line the shores. The Lake lies to the South of Nakuru in the Rift Valley and is protected by the Lake Nakuru National Park. The ecosystem of Lake Nakuru comprises of the lake, surrounded by mainly wooded and bushy grassland. The park provides for about 56 different species of mammals including the White Rhinos and buffaloes. A variety of terrestrial birds including Flamingoes are found in this park. Enjoy game viewing en route to arrive at **Lake Nakuru Flamingo Camp** in time for lunch. Afternoon enjoy a game drive in Lake Nakuru and visit the Baboon Cliff which is a spectacular view point of the Lake. After sunset, return to the Camp for dinner and overnight.

Day 10: Lake Nakuru National Park - Nairobi

Wake up at 0630hrs and depart for an early morning game drive and later enjoy the morning with your breakfast. After which “Full of lasting safari memories!” you will bid Lake Nakuru National Park “kwaheri” meaning good bye and depart to drive to Nairobi meditating the awesome moments on your safari. On arrival in Nairobi, you will be dropped off to your own onward plans or as advised / discussed with you.
