



## 10 DAYS LUXURY - EXPLORE KENYA SAFARI – CODE: ASA/LUX/RDT10

### DESTINATIONS

Samburu National Reserve, Lake Naivasha, Maasai Mara Game Reserve, Lake Nakuru National Park and Amboseli National Park

### ITINERARY

#### Day 1:

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), Nairobi Kenya you will be met and greeted by our AsaRay Tours representation who will assist you with your luggage and help settle you in your transfer van. Once settled in your van, he/she will accompany you to your hotel in Nairobi where you will relax. Spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure.

#### Dinner and overnight at Nairobi Serena Hotel - BB

#### Day 2:

Early in the morning after your breakfast, your Safari Driver/Guide will meet you at the hotel's reception. After a short briefing on your safari, he will assist you to board your safari vehicle and immediately after, you depart to drive to Samburu National Reserve. Samburu is both arid and semi arid with hot days and cool nights. This reserve is rich in game with many rare species including Grevy's Zebra, Somali Ostrich, reticulated giraffe, Gerenuk, Beisa Oryx etc. Kamunyak the miracle lioness that adopted the baby Oryx is a resident in the reserve. Over 450 species of birds have been recorded in this reserve. With game viewing en route you will arrive at Ashnil Samburu Camp in time for lunch. In the afternoon enjoy another game drive returning to the Camp for dinner and overnight.

#### Day 3:

Spend the day in Samburu National Reserve enjoying morning and afternoon game drives/treks where possible ensuring to capture every arising opportunity.

#### Day 4:

In the morning, you will wake up and have breakfast. After breakfast, you will depart Samburu National Reserve with game viewing en route and drive to Lake Naivasha. Lake Naivasha is a beautiful Fresh water lake fringed by thick papyrus. The Lake and its surroundings are rich in natural bounty. Most of the Lake is surrounded by forests of yellow barked Acacia or Yellow fever tree. The Forest abounds with bird life which makes it the best birding destination. The lake draws wild game like Giraffe, Buffalos, Colobus monkeys etc. and Hippos population sleep the day out in the Lakes waters. You will arrive in time for lunch at Crescent Camp. In the afternoon enjoy a boat ride (Optional at an extra cost) or a nature walk along the lake returning to the Camp for dinner and overnight.

#### Dinner and Overnight at Lake Naivasha Crescent Camp - FB

#### Day 5:

Early in the morning, after breakfast you will depart Lake Naivasha and drive to Maasai Mara Game Reserve. Maasai Mara is open grassland. 95 species of mammals, amphibians, reptiles and over 400 species of birds have been recorded in this park. In Maasai Mara you will hardly miss to see the BIG FIVE. The annual wildebeest migration takes place in this park between July and October. The eco system of Maasai Mara holds one of the highest Lion densities in the world and this is where over 2 million Wildebeest, Zebras and Thomson Gazelle migrate every year. You will enjoy the drive to Maasai Mara passing various Maasai traditional homes and villages and enjoying the scenic beauty along this road to arrive at Ashnil Mara Camp in time for lunch. In the afternoon enjoy a game drive until sunset returning to the Camp in time for dinner.

#### Dinner and Overnight at Ashnil Mara Camp - FB

**Day 6:**

Spend the day in Maasai Mara Game Reserve enjoying morning and afternoon game drives. Early in the morning you have an option of doing an early morning Hot Air Balloon Safari + Champagne Breakfast (Optional at an extra cost of USD \$ 480 per person). Maasai Mara is home to the famous Maasai people well known for their distinctive custom and dress. Early afternoon you will visit a typical Maasai village and enjoy being part of this unique culture and cultural habits that not even the western influence has been able to change. Ensure to capture the moment with enough souvenirs. Later continue with your game drive until sunset returning to the Lodge for dinner and overnight.

**Dinner and Overnight at Ashnil Mara Camp – FB****Day 7:**

Early morning take your breakfast. After breakfast, depart Maasai Mara Game Reserve and drive to Lake Nakuru National Park. Lake Nakuru is one of the Rift Valley Soda Ash Lakes. The Lakes abundance of algae attracts the vast quantity of Flamingoes that famously line the shores. The Lake lies to the South of Nakuru in the Rift Valley and is protected by the Lake Nakuru National Park. The ecosystem of Lake Nakuru comprises of the lake, surrounded by mainly wooded and bushy grassland. The park provides for about 56 different species of mammals including the White Rhinos and buffaloes. A variety of terrestrial birds including Flamingoes are found in this park. Enjoy game viewing en route to arrive at Sarova Lion Hill Lodge in time for lunch. Afternoon enjoy a game drive in Lake Nakuru and visit the Baboon Cliff which is a spectacular view point of the Lake. After sunset, return to the Lodge for dinner and overnight.

**Dinner and Overnight at Sarova at Lion Hill Lodge - FB****Day 8:**

Wake up and have early breakfast. After breakfast depart Lake Nakuru with game viewing en route and drive Amboseli National Park. Amboseli is part of the Savannah plains with a high population of both bird and animal species. Amboseli has a mixed topography of plains, acacia woodland, rocky thorn bush, swamps and marshes. The diversity, along with a long dry season, ensures excellent viewing of the large concentrations of African Animals living in this natural habitat. Amboseli offers some of the best opportunities to see African animals because its vegetation is sparse due to the long dry months. This is the only park where Africa's tallest Mt. Kilimanjaro acts as a back drop while on a game drive. The view of this mountain when the clouds open out is spectacular! You will enjoy game viewing en route to arrive at Amboseli Serena Lodge in time for lunch. In the afternoon enjoy a game drive until sunset returning to the Lodge for dinner and overnight.

**Dinner and overnight at Amboseli Serena Lodge - FB****Day 9:**

Spend the day in Amboseli National Park enjoying full day game drives / walks where possible ensuring to uncover Mt. Kilimanjaro and being keen to any arising opportunity.

**Dinner and overnight at Amboseli Serena Lodge - FB****Day 10:**

Early morning, you will do a morning game drive in Amboseli National Park. This game drive is most recommended because it enables you capture the hunting animals with luck. Return to the lodge for breakfast and after breakfast, leisurely prepare to depart Amboseli. ***"Full of lasting memories!"*** you will depart Amboseli and drive leisurely back to Nairobi. On arrival in Nairobi, you will have early dinner at the famous Carnivore Restaurant. After dinner, you will be transferred to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport to board your International flight or dropped to own onward plans.
