Nairobi

ITINERARY

Nairobi is the capital city of Kenya. Nairobi city has tremendously grown since Kenya's independence. It is now a cosmopolitan city with a mix of people from different cultures and backgrounds and even including from different areas in the world. This cultures and backgrounds have greatly influenced the way of life around Nairobi and thus it can seem that the beauty of the culture of the community around Nairobi was long gone! Not a true fact and today we will experience the historic beauty of this town and its uniqueness in terms of travel and culture!

In the morning after your breakfast, 0700hrs, you will be picked up by your Driver/Guide and depart for a city tour of Nairobi. This tour will take you through a rich history, culture, art and adventure. You will visit the David Sheldrick Orphanage – where you will come close to elephant calves! David Sheldrick Conservation Foundation rehabilitates baby elephants and other wildlife here at their home just outside Nairobi National Park. At 1100 hrs you will enjoy viewing the feeding of the elephants. You will then proceed to the National Museum, well known for its spell binding exhibits and displays of early man and tribal regalia. Finally visit the parliament buildings and the Railway station and realize the evolution of the railway system in Kenya. Time allowing the National archives would be a great place to be for a few minutes! Lunch will be served at the Carnivore restaurant or similar!

In the afternoon immediately after lunch you will depart and drive to Kiambu for a few hours of a cultural adventure. Riuki Cultural Centre is where we drive to, to discover the culture of the Central Kenya community – the Kikuyu. Kikuyu are the most liberal community but with a rich preserved culture. The Centre is situated about 25kms from Nairobi and offers tours to African homesteads, performances of African dances, storytelling sessions and a treat of selected dishes from “Mumbi's jiko” – the traditional cuisine. Enjoy a 4hour rich cultural tour while at Riuki which includes a guided tour of the village, traditional doctor cleansing ceremonies, traditional dances, traditional food tasting, a lecture on Kikuyu traditional lifestyle, visits to tea/coffee farms, factories, church, a local school etc.

In the late afternoon after having had the most wonderful experience of culture you will drive back to your hotel in Nairobi and enjoy the rest of the evening at leisure.
