



5 DAYS AIR SAFARI – SAMBURU AND THE MARA CODE: ASA/ADV/AIRT5

DESTINATIONS

Maasai Mara Game Reserve – “The heart of the Great Migration” and Samburu National Reserve

ITINERARY

Day 1:

In the morning of this day, you will be met at your hotel of stay or at JKIA Airport by an AsaRay Tours representation. Depending on time of flight to Samburu, after short briefing, you will be transferred to the Airport where you will board your flight NBO/SAMBURU which departs in the morning. Samburu is both arid and semi arid with hot days and cool nights. This reserve is rich in game with many rare species including Grevy’s Zebra, Somali Ostrich, reticulated giraffe, Gerenuk, Beisa Oryx etc. Kamunyak the miracle lioness that adopted the baby Oryx is a resident in the reserve. Over 450 species of birds have been recorded in this reserve. On arrival at Samburu Airstrip, you will be met and with game viewing en route, drive to your Camp to arrive in time for lunch. Afternoon enjoy a game drive in Samburu ensuring not to miss out on any arising opportunity! After sunset return to the Camp.

Day 2:

Spend the day in Samburu with morning and afternoon game drives. Time allowing you can visit the Samburu villages where you get a chance to interact with the colorful Samburu people in their traditional setting and experience their culture! (Optional at an extra cost)

Day 3:

An early morning game drive would be a good adventure! Breakfast at the Camp and thereafter transferred to the Airstrip for your flight Samburu/NBO. On arrival in Nairobi, you will connect your flight NBO / Maasai Mara. Maasai Mara is open grassland. 95 species of mammals, amphibians, reptiles and over 400 species of birds have been recorded in this park. In Maasai Mara you will hardly miss to see the BIG FIVE. The annual wildebeest migration takes place in this park between July and October. The eco system of Maasai Mara holds one of the highest Lion densities in the world and this is where over 2 million Wildebeest, Zebras and Thomson Gazelle migrate every year. On arrival in Maasai Mara, you will be met at the Airstrip by your Driver/Guide, who will then transfer you to the Camp with game viewing en route. You will arrive at the Camp in time for Dinner and overnight.

Day 4:

Spend the day in Maasai Mara enjoying morning and afternoon game drives with a visit to the Maasai village (optional at an extra cost)

Day 5:

0630hrs an early morning game drive might just be a reason to celebrate since the chances of seeing the hunters e.g. the Lion hunting its prey are very high! Return to the Camp for breakfast. Spend the mid morning at leisure, have early lunch after which, with your bags packed, you will bid Maasai Mara “kwaheri” meaning goodbye and “full of lasting safari memories!” you will be transferred to the Airstrip to board your flight to Nairobi. On arrival in Nairobi, you will be met and dropped to own onward plans.
