



9 DAYS – MISSIONARY EXPERIENCE – CODE: ASA/MISS/RDT9

DESTINATIONS

Nairobi, Mombasa, Kijabe, Nakuru, and Kisumu

ITINERARY

Day 1:

On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), you will be met and greeted at the Airport with an AsaRay Tours officer. He/She will assist you with your luggage after which he/ she will accompany you to board your bus and drive to Mombasa. A lunch stopover at Voi and continue to drive to Mombasa. You will arrive Mombasa late evening and check in at **Milele Beach Hotel**. Spend the rest of the evening at leisure.

Dinner and Overnight at the Milele Beach Hotel - HB

Day 2:

In the morning after breakfast, you will be picked up at 0800hrs to visit the historical side of the coastal town of Mombasa. You will visit the Fort Jesus and the old town of Mombasa. At Fort Jesus you will be taken through the rich history of this fort and slave trade. You will enjoy a guided tour of the fort and then visit the old town. You will then depart to return to your hotel for lunch. After lunch you will prepare yourself to visit the fellowship Baptist church; started in 1983 mainly as a ministry to reach the Asians of Mombasa who remained unchanged since the dawn of Christianity in this shores. Enjoy an afternoon of missionary work and have time for the Bishop take you through the history of the church.

Dinner and Overnight at the Milele Beach Hotel – FB

Day 3:

Early in the morning have your breakfast. Immediately after your breakfast, with picnic lunch, you will board your bus to depart and drive to Nairobi. In Nairobi you will check in at your hotel in the late afternoon and spend the rest of the evening at leisure.

Dinner and Overnight at the Panari Hotel – BB

Day 4:

In the morning after an early breakfast, depart Nairobi and drive to Kijabe, perhaps the world's largest mission station. Take an inspirational visit to the Rift Valley Academy, a school for over 500 children of missionaries stationed throughout the African Continent. The academy seeks within the African context to discipline, nature and educate students towards Christian maturity for the Glory of God. They represent some 80 different missions' organizations in Africa. Later if possible you will attend a briefing session with the father who is in charge of the facility. Thereafter proceed to Lake Nakuru.

Dinner and Overnight at Jumuia Guest House – FB

Day 5:

After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to the Saint Theresa Home of Hope – The HIV children's home is located on the outskirts of Lake Nakuru. The home offers care for children (Girls), who are infected with HIV / AIDS virus. Most of these children have a poor background as well, which makes the situation even more difficult for them. In the afternoon visit the walk centre a not for profit organization committed to helping the children and families of the Hilton Slum area, thereafter visit the Nakuru baby orphanage for the afternoon. Spending time and energy in this place will indeed prove to be a truly noble endeavor, and provide hope for a better world for these children.

Dinner and Overnight at Jumuia Guest House – FB

**Day 6:**

Have breakfast at the hotel and prepare to check out for your departure to Kisumu. Kisumu is the third Metropolitan city in Kenya and is located 110kms southwest of Kitale town. You will check in at your hotel in time for lunch. Have lunch at the hotel and afterwards depart for a city tour of Kisumu "Best of Kisumu" to familiarize yourselves with your hometown for the next three days. This tour will take you through history, culture, adventure etc.

Dinner and overnight at Lake Victoria Safari Village – FB**Day 7:**

This day you will have early breakfast. After breakfast drive to Unyolo village where you will arrive to a rousing welcome by the Unyolo villagers! Enjoy traditional and cultural dances among other entertainment and afterwards enjoy a hearty lunch with the villagers as you interact with them on one on one. After lunch attend a session with the Patron of Unyolo center Dr. Onyango. He will brief you on the following activities undertaken by the Unyolo Center;

- Education programs
- Health/Nutrition program
- Scholarships
- Women Empowerment and Community Co operative(Food production)
- Fair Trade (Handicrafts)
- Eco – tourism/Immersion

After the briefing you can chart out ways of improving the center based on your expertise and knowledge. The briefing will point out the needs of the center and the challenges they face. This will allow you the opportunity to visit the hosts Homesteads and familiarize yourself with the environment. Later in the evening after a fulfilled day you will drive back to Kisumu to your hotel.

Dinner and Overnight at Lake Victoria Safari Village – HB**Day 8:**

In the morning after breakfast, you will enjoy a 2-3hrs shopping spree at a local market where you will find souvenirs, artifacts, ornaments, bracelets etc. Satisfied with your shopping you will depart Kisumu and drive to Nairobi with a lunch stopover in Nakuru, after which continue to Nairobi to arrive late evening at your hotel.

Dinner and Overnight at Panari Hotel - BB**Day 9:**

This day after your breakfast, visit the Nairobi National Park for the better part of the morning until around 1200hrs. Lunch will be at your leisure and shortly after, drive back to your Hotel to collect your luggage. Later you will have a farewell dinner at the Carnivore Restaurant. After dinner, ***"full of lasting safari memories!"*** you will depart to drive to the Airport (JKIA) in good time (2hrs before departure time for all international flights) to board your flight back home. Here we bid you "kwaheri" meaning Goodbye and wish you a safe flight back home!
